SPONSORSHIP JOCKEYS RIDING PANTS

Rules effective as of 1 August 2002.

The following outlines the regulations and dimensions of a Jockeys **name**, **sponsors name**, **sponsors logo** on areas of Jockeys silks.

Jockey Name (1)

Riders may display their name in the following formats:

Given Christian name and surname:	Michael Walker
First initial and surname:	M Walker
First and second initial and surname:	M J Walker

All riders riding in New Zealand must wear silks displaying their name on both thighs. The lettering must be **black** and the lettering used must not exceed the following dimensions:

Full Name/Surname (2)

Height:	4cm (40mm)
Length:	Up to 27.5cm (275mm)

Given Christian name (3)

Height:	2cm (20mm)
Length:	8cm (80mm)

Sponsors Name (4)

Jockeys may also use the area called the 'Coccyx Site' for displaying a sponsors name, this is the area below the spine. A sponsors name may be displayed in any colour or shape. The dimensions for this area are:

Height:	8cm (80mm)
Length:	20cm (200mm)

Sponsors Logos (5)

Logos are to be displayed above the Jockeys name and have a maximum area of 64 sq cm. A logo may be any shape and colour as long as it is within the specified dimensions. Both sides must have the same logo, therefore multiple sponsors cannot be entertained on one set of silks. The dimensions for this area are:

Height:	8cm (80mm)
Length:	8cm (80mm)
