Terms and Conditions - Prize Draw

1. Entry into the Prize Draw is deemed to be acceptance of these Terms and Conditions. Entries that do not comply with these Terms and Conditions or entries that are late, lost, misdirected, incomplete, indecipherable, or illegible will be deemed invalid; and New Zealand Thoroughbred Racing (NZTR) takes no responsibility for such entries. All entries will remain the property of the NZTR.
2. To be eligible to enter the Prize Draw, customers must:
 - (a) Own a share in a thoroughbred race horse that is currently being trained in New Zealand.
 - (b) Fully complete either an online or mailed out hard copy of the NZTR Ownership Questionnaire. As part of this the survey must either be completed online using the IER Customer Direct service (**NZTR Ownership Questionnaire**) or if completed in hard copy; the survey must be mailed to:

A fully completed survey form must include the entrant's first name, surname, date of birth, and contact email or postal address.
 - (c) Ensure that the fully completed survey is received via the applicable method, by 5:00pm on Friday the 24th of April 2015.
 - (d) Be 18 years of age or over. (NZTR reserves the right to require any customer to produce identification, including proof of age.)
3. Once NZTR has received a fully completed NZTR Ownership Questionnaire; customers will be automatically entered into the Prize Draw.
4. Each owner can only complete one online OR one had copy questionnaire; and only one entry per owner into the Prize Draw will be permitted.
5. The owner that wins the Prize Draw will win a one off \$1,000.00 contribution towards their thoroughbred race horse's training fees (**the Prize**). The Prize is valid to be claimed within one calendar year from the date of issue; failure to claim the Prize within this time will result in its forfeiture to NZTR.
6. The following persons are not eligible to enter the Prize Draw:
 - (a) Board members, employees, agents (and agents' employees), contractors of NZTR, and the Immediate Family of such persons. "Immediate Family" of a person means the parents, siblings, children and spouse or partner (whether legal or de facto) of that person.
7. Only the owner who originally entered the Prize Draw can be awarded the Prize.
8. The Prize must be paid directly into the New Zealand bank account of the trainer or Authorised Syndicator which the owner/prize winner elects. The owner can only elect a trainer or Authorised Syndicator with whom the owner's horse is or will be trained by,, and who is operating in New Zealand. Only one trainer or Authorised Syndicator may be elected, and the Prize, or any unused portion of the Prize, is not transferable and cannot be exchanged for alternative products or services or redeemed for cash.
9. A random draw from all eligible entries will be made in the presence of designated NZTR representatives. The final decision in respect of any winning entry will be at the sole discretion of NZTR and no correspondence will be entered into. The Prize Draw will be conducted on Friday the 8th of May 2015.
10. The winning owner will be contacted after the draw by email, phone, or mail. If NZTR is unable to contact the winning owner by 5:00pm two weeks (14 calendar days) after the draw was conducted, having made reasonable efforts to do so, the winner's entry will be declared invalid and NZTR reserves the right to randomly redraw another winner on the same terms and conditions as the original draw.

NZTR reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of entries and entrants, and to disqualify any owner who submits an entry that is not in accordance with these Terms & Conditions, or who tampers with the entry process or attempts to act in a fraudulent or dishonest manner, as ineligible to participate in the Prize Draw.

To be eligible to claim the Prize, a winner must first agree to the use of his/her name, place of residence, image, and photograph(s), by NZTR and/or any participating company running this competition, for publicity and promotional purposes, without compensation, and agrees to make himself/herself reasonably available for publicity, photographs, and filming. NZTR will own copyright in any such images and photograph(s), and in all material incorporating the photograph(s) or film.
13. If the Prize Draw cannot be run as planned for reasons beyond the control of NZTR; NZTR reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend this competition and/or these terms and conditions at any time.
14. NZTR takes no responsibility for any inability to enter, complete, continue, or conclude the Prize Draw due to equipment or technical malfunction, Acts of God or otherwise.

Except for any liability that cannot be excluded by law, NZTR and any person in connection with this prize draw are not liable for any direct, indirect, special, or consequential loss or damage whatsoever suffered, or personal injury suffered or sustained in connection with (i) participation in this competition; (ii) the Prize or use of the Prize; and (iii) the administration of this competition and distribution of the Prize.
16. Failure by NZTR to enforce any of its rights under these Terms & Conditions at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.
17. The personal information provided by each owner in entering this competition will be held by NZTR in accordance with the Privacy Act 1993. The personal information will be stored on NZTR's database and may be used only by NZTR for the following purposes: randomly selecting the winning survey entry and for contacting the winner of survey competition. NZTR may delegate authority in this regard as it sees fit.
